Relocation of the parking deck at Medicinaregatan 18

The parking deck at Medicinaregatan 18 is currently being dismantled in order to be relocated elsewhere in Sweden for reuse. The area will be prepared for ground-level parking and is expected to reopen in late week 11 or early week 12. Later this summer, the area will also be further improved to enhance safety and the overall campus environment.

While the parking deck is being dismantled, the area will be cordoned off and motorists are referred to other parking facilities across the campus area, as well as to the parking lot below the allotment garden area. The pedestrian path to and from Konstspidemin is also temporarily closed.

Food and food trucks

In November, Bistro Science opened in the former Lunchen.nu premises at Medicinaregatan 8A. The concept continues with opening hours from 8:30 to 15:30. Bistro Science shares the following update: Friday burgers will be served during the spring – “From open charcoal grill to juicy burger – premiere on 27 March at a great price!” The current food truck location by the Lundberg Laboratory will be moved to Academicum, where there will soon be space for two food trucks at the same location.

Bicycle parking

In October, work began to replace the old, worn bicycle shelters with new ones. This means that certain areas may be temporarily cordoned off and that you may need to use a different bicycle parking area for a period of time. The installation of the new bicycle shelters is expected to be completed shortly.

Window replacement – Anatomy mezzanine level

The window replacement work in the Anatomy building, mezzanine level, has now been completed. Window replacement in the Histology building will begin in week 13, when scaffolding will be installed. The window replacement itself will start the following week, week 14. The work is expected to be completed by week 22.

LED lighting

The replacement of indoor lighting with LED lighting is ongoing across the campus. Work is currently underway in the library, which is expected to be completed during the spring, and in Academicum, where the work is expected to be completed after the summer holiday period. Next in line are the Hasselblad Laboratory and LNC, where project planning will begin shortly and the lighting replacement is scheduled to start in late spring.

Biodiversity

In the clearing below Lyktan, we will carry out measures during autumn 2025 and spring 2026 to increase biodiversity. We will install bee and pollinator hotels and complement the existing plantings with species that support wild bees.

Traffic safety

In connection with the City of Gothenburg’s development of a new area with housing and a preschool on Guldhedsgatan, the City and Akademiska Hus are planning to jointly improve the junction where Medicinaregatan splits towards the Biomedical Library and past the allotment garden area towards Guldhedsgatan.

The junction will be redesigned to make it clearer how motorists, cyclists and pedestrians should interact with each other. The measures are expected to begin in autumn 2026.
